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Overview

Raja Ampat, or “Four Kings”, is one of the most rich and diverse dive destinations in the world. Centered in the heart of the Coral Triangle in Indonesia, this elaborate coral ecosystem is comprised of over 1,500 islands, 600 types of corals, 1,500 species of fish, and 600 types of mollusks. Join the graceful manta rays, clouds of schooling fish, and fascinating macro life on over 20 dives throughout this 7-day scuba diving live-aboard expedition on the Raja Ampat Aggressor.

Summary Itinerary

The official itinerary is varied given the time of year, weather conditions, and other variables. Your trip begins and ends in Sorong, West Papua, Indonesia.

Detailed Itinerary

Day 1 | Arrival/Departure from Sorong

For all itineraries, the flight arrival times are in the morning and afternoon. We highly recommend guests overnight the day before departure at a local hotel then guests will be picked up at 12 pm upon checkout (on day of charter departure) and transferred to the yacht as long as guests are staying in the vicinity of where the yacht docks.

Boarding 1 pm with yacht departure 4 pm

With all on board, you will be introduced to your respective staterooms to get acquainted with your living accommodations. Followed, is your first of many meals together as you sail to your first destination.

Day 2-6 | Diving

There will be multiple dives each day during this trip. Your dives will take place within North and Central Raja Ampat. While each itinerary is subject to variation due to weather conditions, here are some highlights of the Raja Ampat route:

The Raja Ampat itinerary combines the best dive sites of Dampier Strait, Fam, Mansuar and the awesome dive sites of Misool, the best diving area of Raja Ampat. The great highlights are the manta cleaning station near Mansuar and the huge schools of fish near Farondi.

The Dampier straight separates the Birdhead Peninsula from Waigeo and Mansuar. The name comes from the Dutch colonial times. It refers to the shape of the peninsula on the map, but it is also a paradise for many rare bird species.

Here the Pacific Ocean meets the Halmahera Sea, with an explosion of marine life as consequence. With regular strong currents, big fish feel especially comfortable. Manta rays, reef sharks, different schools of mackerel, tuna and barracuda, dolphin and whales may be seen.

The night dives under the Arborek or Cape Mansuar jetty is a favorite spot with peculiar creatures such as wobbegongs, epaulette sharks (walking sharks), nudibranchs, pipefish, seahorses, frogfish, scorpion fish and the list goes on.

Day 7 | Last Dives and Farewells

Your last day will consist of your last dives. At the end of the day, all guests and crew gather for a farewell party, including music and food. It is an opportunity to give thanks to everyone on board and to distribute some awards!

Dinner is followed by an explanation of the check out procedure as well as a slide show with some pictures taken by guests.
